### Get involved with the Parents Association Board

Did you know that all parents/family members of enrolled Illinois State University students are automatically members of the Parents Association? Throughout the year, the Parents Association Board (PAB) stays in touch with you through this newsletter and participates in various university activities and events.

Board members attend quarterly, on-campus meetings and serve as the voice of parents and families. Illinois State University President Al Bowman and Vice President for Student Affairs Steve Adams participate in each meeting. They provide the PAB with updates regarding nearly everything that is happening at the University. The question and answer portion of their presentations is a vital part of their communication to us, and us with them, as members of the PAB and as parents of currently enrolled students.

## How to get on the Dean's List

Undergraduate students who meet high academic standards, as established by the college of their major, are included in a Dean's List issued each semester.

Students are required to complete 12 or more semester hours to be considered for the Dean's List. Courses completed after the official end of the semester and courses taken with a credit/no credit option are not counted for this purpose.

The Dean's List for the Colleges of Applied Science and Technology, Arts and Sciences, Education, Fine Arts, and Mennonite College of Nursing will include those students whose grade point average places them among the top 10 percent of those students majoring within the college based on their semester GPA. The Dean's List in the College of Business will include only undergraduate students majoring in business who have completed 12 or more semester hours with an overall semester grade point in the top 10 percent and an average of at least 3.33 for all courses taken during the semester. Again, courses completed after the official end of the semester and courses taken with a credit/no credit option will not be counted for this purpose.

Students whose major does not place them in one of the six colleges that offer degrees and whose semester grade point average is within the top 10 percent of the University are identified on the List of the Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Studies.

## Watterson Commons Dining Center renovation update

Renovations to the Watterson Commons dining center began this summer. Renovations are broken into six phases:

- Phase one—Summer 2009
- Phase two—Fall 2009
- Phase three—Winter break 2009–2010
- Phase four—Spring 2010
- Phase five—Summer 2010
- Phase six—Fall 2010

Each phase is scheduled for completion at the end of the time period listed. Contractors are on schedule and have made great progress.

The dining center will remain open during the renovation and provide full meal service. The area of the dining center that is under construction will be walled off and students will have access to the remaining part of the facility.

## The potential “rhythm” of the academic year

College is a unique experience for students and their families. Whether it is the student’s first year of college or their last, they will face many different situations.

The following is a list of typical themes that may occur during the first months of the academic year. This will give you a “heads-up” as to what your student may be going through, and allow you a chance to plan ways to help them through it.

### August/September/October

- Homesickness/loneliness
- Excitement
- Readiness to get back to school
- Doubts about choice of school
- Tendency to test new limits and boundaries
- For new students, frequent calls/visits home
- Anxiety about roommate and/or roommates
- Concerns about social environment (“Do I fit in here?”)
- First exams occur, stress of mid-terms
- Love relationships from home still going strong (or not)
- For seniors, concerns regarding post-graduation plans begin to surface

### November/December

- Roommate problems may be getting more serious
- Lots of exams/papers due before Thanksgiving break
- Excitement/anxiety about going home for the holidays
- Anxiety/sleeplessness in preparation for finals
- For freshmen, anxiety over putting together their class schedule for next semester
- For seniors, realization that the “last time” events are starting

## Student Enrichment Fund

Welcome to the Illinois State University family! When your student decided to attend Illinois State, you and your entire family became members of the larger Illinois State family. As a Redbird parent or family member, you will be contacted this year via telephone by a current Illinois State student calling on behalf of the Student Enrichment Fund.

The Student Enrichment Fund strengthens the mission of the Division of Student Affairs through its financial support of initiatives, programs, and outreach activities for Illinois State students. The fund supports activities of Student Affairs units such as Parent Services, the Dean of Students Office, and the Office of the Vice President, as well as Family Weekend and Sibling Weekend. In addition, the fund provides resources to support friend-raising efforts, student and staff professional development, scholarships, necessities for students experiencing hardships due to crisis situations (i.e. fire, flooding, etc.), student memorials, and a variety of other campus programs and initiatives.

Each year, student callers from the Annual Fund contact parents of currently enrolled students seeking donations to this fund. The student callers’ goals are to provide you with a current student’s perspective of Illinois State, to help answer any questions or concerns that you or your student may have, and to increase support for the Student Enrichment Fund. ## How to help your student prepare for a successful job search beginning freshmen year

The Career Center is a valuable central resource for Illinois State University students. We assist students in the exploration of career opportunities that match their talents, interests, and goals, which help students develop job search skills that will aid them in pursuing full-time positions and internships. Students should be proactive in developing the specific skills that will position them above other candidates when applying for a position. These skills are acquired through many venues such as academic classes, research experiences, internships, extracurricular activities, community service, volunteerism, study abroad, alternative spring break opportunities, etc.

Parents have significant influence over the new college student's sense of self-confidence and self-worth. To maintain your student's confidence, your communications with them should consistently identify their strengths. Through the process of clarifying their academic, career, and other lifetime goals, students respect and appreciate when parents:

- Exhibit patience, tolerance, and support when they change directions
- Identify their strengths, limitations, and potential, and allow them to make final choices
- Communicate genuine understanding and/or agreement with the final degree selected

The Career Center has created a Four Year Planner for you to reference as you encourage your student to participate in various activities while in college. Starting early to become involved in on-campus activities allows students time to develop valuable transferable skills that will be beneficial and make them more marketable in their future careers. ### To help students prepare for the employment landscape of the future, parents can encourage students to:

- Take classes applicable to more than one career and life direction
- Seek opportunities to interact with others who are not like them
- Take interest and ability assessments to help determine their strengths, interests, and values
- Develop computer skills and familiarity with online resources
- Take classes to enhance communication skills
- Participate in campus and community organizations
- Frequently visit the career center and academic advisors to stay apprised of where they are in accomplishing their academic and career goals
- Study a second language
- Study abroad
- Experience internships
- Participate in community service activities

### What are employers looking for in a qualified candidate?

According to the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE), employers are looking for a combination of "soft skills" in prospective candidates such as good communication skills and leadership abilities. A great recruiting philosophy is the SWAN approach. Look for students who are smart, well-rounded, ambitious, and nice.

## Watterson Towers Renovation Project

In 2003, the Board of Trustees approved the Long Range Housing and Dining Plan that was created to provide vision and direction to update the residence halls on campus. Watterson Towers is the sixth residence hall to be renovated. It was opened in 1968 and is home to approximately 2,200 students. The renovation project has both an exterior and interior component. And while the wish list of items was longer than the budget permits, once completed, the plans include addressing several major deferred maintenance items, updating the appearance, expanding the sprinkler system, and adding wireless capability throughout the facility. The project will kick off during March 2010 with the beginning stages of facade repairs. As this exterior work is seasonal, this work is scheduled to take place between March and October, weather permitting, for the duration of the renovation. The interior work will begin in May 2010. As this renovation project will occur while the building is occupied, University Housing Services staff has established several communication methods to keep residents and others informed about the progress of the project and will be using our Web site at [www.Housing.ilstu.edu](http://www.Housing.ilstu.edu) to provide updates about our progress.
