

Fall 2025 Sorority & Fraternity Life Executive Summary



Academics

- The Fall 2025 All-SFL GPA of 3.14 is the highest community-wide GPA since 1998.
- 19 chapters' semester GPA is above the All-ISU average of 3.18.
- The Fall 2025 All-CPC GPA of 3.39 is above the All-Female ISU average of 3.28.
- The Fall 2025 All-IFC GPA of 3.11 is above the All-Male ISU average of 2.78

Leadership Development & Community Engagement

- SFL continued three eLearning training courses during the Fall of 2025. During members' first semester in the SFL community, they completed the Hazing Prevention and Brave & Bold Dialogues, and in their second semester, they completed the Hazing Prevention – FSL Module.
 - 402 members completed the Hazing Prevention 101 training.
 - 356 members completed the Brave & Bold Dialogues: DEI training.
 - 353 members completed the Fraternity & Sorority Life Module.
- Order of Omega, SFL Honor Society, welcomed 44 members in the Fall 2025 semester.

Recruitment & Expansion

- The SFL community totaled 2200 members during the Fall 2025 semester.
- Currently, 11% of Illinois State University students are fraternity or sorority members.
- Six of the nine NPHC fraternities and sororities brought in 35 new members this fall.
- One of the five UGC fraternities and sororities brought in three new members this fall.
- 13 of the 13 IFC fraternities welcomed 269 new members this fall.
 - Delta Sigma Phi joined the community this fall.
- 11 of the 11 CPC sororities welcomed 322 new members this fall.

Service & Philanthropy

- During the Fall 2025 semester, fraternity and sorority members completed 8,700 hands-on community service hours. This is the sixth semester this data has been tracked. This reflects what was reported in 12 chapters.
- During the Fall 2025 semester, \$115,596 was raised for charities by fraternities and sororities. This is the fourth semester this data has been tracked. This reflects what was reported in 10 chapters.
