Fall 2024 Sorority & Fraternity Life Executive Summary

Academics

- The Fall 2024 All-SFL GPA of 3.07 is consistent with the All-ISU average of 3.15.
- 19 chapters semester GPA is above the All-ISU average of 3.15.
- The Fall 2024 All-CPC GPA of 3.33 is above the All-ISU Female average of 3.26.
- The Fall 2024 All-NPHC Sorority GPA of 3.17 is above the All-ISU average of 3.15.

Leadership Development & Community Engagement

- SFL continued three eLearning training courses during the Fall of 2024. During a member's first semester in the SFL community, they complete the Hazing Prevention 101 and Brave & Bold Dialogues, and in their second semester, they complete the Hazing Prevention FSL Module.
 - 466 members completed the Hazing Prevention 101 training.
 - o 378 members completed the Brave & Bold Dialogues: DEI training.
 - o 380 members completed the Hazing Prevention- FSL Module
- Order of Omega, SFL Honor Society welcomed 52 new members in the Fall 2024 semester.
- 200+ students attended and engaged in hazing prevention programming occurring in the Fall 2024 semester, featuring two unique lunch and learn collaborations with campus partners, a hazing awareness women's volleyball game, and an immersive hazing museum that featured nine exhibits covering hazing cases in various university contexts.
- UGC, NPHC, CPC, IFC, and Order of Omega transitioned officers in December. SFL hosted the 2nd Annual Officer Installation Ceremony to celebrate our community's outgoing and incoming leaders.
- Over 725 SFL community members actively participated in SFL Weekend of Events programming tailed towards building a stronger, more unified community.

Recruitment, Retention & Expansion

- The retention of all-SFL freshmen members is currently 90.2% compared to the retention of all-Illinois state freshmen at 81.4%. (Note that this information is only reported in the fall, so this will be updated in fall 2025.)
- The SFL community totaled 2,121 members during the Fall 2024 semester. This is 1,318 sorority members and 803 fraternity members.
- Currently, 11% of Illinois State University State students are fraternity or sorority members.
- Two of the nine NPHC fraternities and sororities brought in 22 new members this fall.
- Three of the four UGC fraternities and sororities brought in 10 new members this fall.
 - o Phi Rho Eta Fraternity, Inc. is currently expanding into the UGC.
- 13 of the 15 IFC fraternities welcomed 211 new members this fall.
 - o Alpha Gamma Rho joined the IFC community in the fall.
- 12 of the 12 CPC sororities welcomed 370 new members this fall.

Service & Philanthropy

- During the Fall 2024 semester, fraternity and sorority members completed 10,622 hands-on community service hours. This is the third semester this data has been tracked for many years. This reflects what was reported in 17 chapters.
- During the Fall 2024 semester, \$63,541 was raised for charities by fraternities and sororities. This is the second semester this data has been tracked in many years. This reflects what was reported in 8 chapters.
