Spring 2025 Sorority & Fraternity Life Executive Summary

Academics

- The Spring 2025 All-SFL GPA of 3.12 is the highest community GPA since 1998.
- 17 chapters, semester GPA is above the All-ISU average of 3.21.
- The Spring 2025 All-CPC GPA of 3.4 is above the All-ISU Female average of 3.21.
- The Spring 2025 All-IFC GPA of 3.06 is consistent with the All-Male ISU GPA, the All-IFC GPA is the highest in over a decade.

Leadership Development & Community Engagement

- SFL continued three eLearning training courses during the Spring of 2025. During a member's first semester in the SFL community, they complete the Hazing Prevention 101 and Brave & Bold Dialogues, and in their second semester, they complete the Hazing Prevention – FSL Module.
 - 136 members completed the Hazing Prevention 101 training, bringing our 2024-25 completion to 602.
 - 162 members completed the Brave & Bold Dialogues: DEI training, bringing our 2024-25 completion to 540.
 - 107 members completed the Hazing Prevention- FSL Module, bringing our 2024-25 completion to 487.
- Order of Omega, SFL Honor Society, welcomed 35 new members in the Spring 2025 semester.
- In February, 32 students representing all four councils attended the Association of Fraternal Leadership & Values Central Conference in Indianapolis, IN.

Recruitment, Retention & Expansion

- The retention of all-SFL freshmen members is currently 90.2% compared to the retention of all-Illinois state freshmen at 81.4%. (Note that this information is only reported in the fall, so this will be updated in fall 2025.)
- The SFL community totaled 2,038 members during the Spring 2025 semester. This is 1,326 sorority members and 693 fraternity members. (Note that 2 fraternities closed during the spring semester.)
- Currently, 12% of Illinois State University students are sorority or fraternity members.
- Six of the nine NPHC fraternities and sororities brought in 42 neophytes this spring.
- Three of the four UGC fraternities and sororities brought in 12 neophytes this spring.
 - Phi Rho Eta Fraternity, Inc. is currently expanding into the UGC.
- 12 of the 14 IFC fraternities welcomed 51 new members this spring.
- 12 of the 12 CPC sororities welcomed 109 new members this spring.

Service & Philanthropy

- During the Spring 2025 semester, fraternity and sorority members completed 9,900 hands-on community service hours. This is the fourth semester this data has been tracked for many years. This reflects what was reported in 23 chapters.
- During the Spring 2025 semester, \$193,983 was raised for charities by fraternities and sororities. This is the fourth semester this data has been tracked in many years. This reflects what was reported in 21 chapters.
