

Spring 2026 Sorority & Fraternity Life Executive Summary

Academics

- The Spring 2026 All-SFL semester GPA was 3.11.
- 14 chapters' semester GPA is above the All-ISU average of 3.22.
- The Spring 2026 All-CPC GPA of 3.38 is above the All-Female ISU average of 3.33.
- The Spring 2026 All-IFC GPA of 3.10 is above the All-Male ISU average of 3.08.

Leadership Development & Community Engagement

- SFL continued three eLearning training courses during the Spring of 2026. During members' first semester in the SFL community, they completed the Hazing Prevention and Brave & Bold Dialogues, and the FSL Module.
 - 455 members completed the Hazing Prevention 101 training.
 - 459 members completed the Brave & Bold Dialogues: DEI training.
 - 486 members completed the Fraternity & Sorority Life Module.
- Order of Omega, SFL Honor Society, welcomed 40 members in the Spring 2026 semester.

Retention & Recruitment

- The retention of all-SFL freshmen members is currently 92.1% compared to the retention of all-Illinois state freshmen at 81.9%. (Note that this information is only reported in the Fall, so this will be updated in Fall 2026.)
- The SFL community totaled 2143 members during the Spring 2026 semester.
- Currently, 11.87% of Illinois State University students are fraternity or sorority members.
- The SFL community welcomed 229 new members this spring.
 - Four of the nine NPHC fraternities and sororities brought in new members, totaling 54.
 - Four of the seven UGC fraternities and sororities brought in new members, totaling 19.
 - 12 of the 13 IFC fraternities brought in new members, totaling 60.
 - 11 of the 11 CPC sororities brought in new members, totaling 96.

Service & Philanthropy

- During the Spring 2026 semester, fraternity and sorority members completed 8,839.5 hands-on community service hours. This reflects what was reported in 22 chapters.
- During the Spring 2026 semester, \$198,748.55 was raised for charities by fraternities and sororities. This reflects what was reported in 17 chapters.
